After a few years of work at a clinic, she became the manager and now oversees more than 10 employees. Her next dream is to open her own private clinic and serve families and children living with disabilities, HIV and others who have a difficult time finding the medical care they need.

The dream will have to wait for now as she has just given birth to her first child. Roja and Matthew were married last year and are now new parents.
