

When Sandeep first came to Hope Now he was a quiet child who kept to himself. Early on, during one of his monthly visits to the health clinic, we came to know he had significant hearing loss. He suffered from years of ear infections that left a good deal of scaring which led to significant hearing loss. As you can imagine, school was difficult because he could not hear. Once we figured that out, he had a number of surgeries and continued healthcare to monitor his hearing. This year, he decided it was time to get some hearing aids. He could no longer hear in his right ear and his left ear was down to 40%. Seeing the smile on his face when he first turned them on was priceless.

Sandeep will be taking his exams in September. With his new hearing aids, he is looking forward to a successful outcome.
